

Extended Day Winter Session November 30, 2009 - February 11, 2010

Dear Parents,

November 2009

The Carroll School Extended Day Program will start its winter session on November 30th and will continue until February 11th. We are offering: Board games, Basketball, Hockey, Board Games, Computer Club, Knitting, Lower Fun/Homework, Lower School Science Club, Supervised Study, Wii, Cooking and Winter Explorers.

Below are the days, time and age requirements for each activity. Any activity may be withdrawn if the enrollment is insufficient (minimum of 6). The maximum number of students per activity is also listed below thus, it is important to list several options for your child.

Hockey

Max 28 **Fridays in January and February**

5th-8th grade Students \$200

Interscholastic; practice and competition against other schools

Basketball

Max **4 days a week Monday thru Thursday**

Middle Students \$300

Interscholastic; practice and competition against other schools

We can have a maximum of 42 boys & 28 girls. At which point three teams for boys and two teams for girls will be created

Boardgames

Max. 6 **2 days a week Tuesdays & Thursdays**

All Students \$160

This is an opportunity for your child to socialize with their peers and to play various boardgames, card games, and dominoes.

Cooking

Max. 6 **2 days a week**

Monday & Wednesdays

Lower School \$180

Come learn how to cook. The first day students will pick a recipe write the ingredients and then purchase them. On the second day students will prepare, cook the meal and enjoy what was made. Followed by cleaning up. Because of the ingredients and materials an additional fee has been added to the cost of the program.

Computer Club

Max. 7 **2 days a week Tuesdays & Thursdays**

5th-8th grade Students \$160

Come learn computer programming and create your own computer games. We will be using a piece of computer software called "Scratch", which was developed at MIT to help children learn computer programming. Students will learn all sorts of different computer skills and computer programs such as Garage Band and iMovie.

Knitting and Gift Making

Max. 6 **2 days a week Mondays & Wednesdays**

All Students \$180

Learn to make nice gifts to treat yourself or give to some lucky person. Each student will make a warm, woolly hat using a round loom. You can also learn the basics of knit and purl on needles to make a scarf or mittens. Sand art and terrariums will be another craft project. Stop by Spaulding Room 202 to see examples displayed. Hours of enjoyment, especially on long, cold winter nights, are possible!
