



# Lesley University International Admissions Guide

*Follow these steps:*

## **#1 INQUIRE**

Investigate our program offerings online at [www.lesley.edu](http://www.lesley.edu) and request an online application by sending an email to [info@lesley.edu](mailto:info@lesley.edu) or calling 617-349-8300.

## **#2 APPLY**

Submit required materials, as outlined in the application to:

## **#3 WAIT**

Our staff will process application materials as they arrive. Once the application is complete, it will be submitted to the department for review.

## **#4 SUBMIT IMMIGRATION DOCUMENTS**

Once accepted, you will be required to submit immigration and financial documents to the address in Step #2. Your documents will then be sent to the International Student Services (ISS) office for processing of an I-20.

## **#5 RECEIVE I-20**

Pending any unforeseen circumstances, you will receive an I-20 Certificate of Eligibility. At this stage, you are primarily in contact with the ISS office about your unique immigration situation.

## **#6 ARRIVE, REGISTER, & ENROLL**

Pending any limitations, you will arrive in the U.S. on an F-1 student visa, fulfill necessary ISS requirements, register for classes and begin your program.

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*Complete 5 months prior to start term, unless indicated otherwise in application*

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*If everything is on track, this should happen 2-3 months prior to start term*

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*This happens about 1-2 months prior to start term*
