## FREE EARLY LITERACY SCREENING



Carroll School is offering free early intervention screening for entering 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students in order to help parents assess whether their child is at risk for encountering reading difficulties.

The screening will include:  
Phonological Awareness, Rapid Letter Naming, and Decoding

“If I could give three measures to every Kindergarten teacher to predict fluency, it would be: 1) a phoneme awareness task; 2) a set of rapid automatized naming tests (for letters, numbers, colors, objects); 3) a vocabulary test.”
