F. Gorham Brigham honored with Lifetime Achievement Award

Boston, MA - July 16, 2009 – On Thursday, financial executive F. Gorham Brigham was presented with the Lifetime Achievement Award at the 2009 CFO of the Year Awards. The awards, presented by the Boston Business Journal, were held at the Park Plaza Hotel in Boston.

This was the first annual CFO of the Year Awards, and the honorees were awarded on their leadership and accomplishments in guiding their businesses' financial operations. They were also recognized based on their community involvement. Out of the 16 total recognized individuals, 94 year old F. Gorham Brigham was singled out and honored for his contributions to both the financial world, and the betterment of society.

A graduate from Harvard in the late 1930s, Brigham also served in the military until 1946, and remained in the Army Reserve until 1967, when he retired as Colonel. As far as his work in finance, Brigham's career includes positions such as Vice President of Boston Five Cent Savings Bank and Senior Vice President of Citizen's Bank, where he retired in 2005. Brigham is also known for co-founding The Carroll School for children with dyslexia and founding the Treasurer's Club of Boston.

During Thursday's award ceremony, Michael Olivieri, publisher for the Boston Business Journal, presented Brigham with the Lifetime Achievement Award, which he stated would now be referred to as the "F. Gorham Brigham Award". Brigham took to the stage during a standing ovation and expressed his sincere gratitude. "I would call this the highlight of my career", the 94 year old said to the audience.
