

Fall Session - Extended Day

Below are the days, time, and age requirements for each activity. Any activity may be withdrawn if the enrollment is insufficient (minimum of 6). The maximum number of students per activity is listed below, when registering please consider first and second choice activities for your child.

Art

Max. 6 2 days a week Monday & Wednesday Lower students \$210
 Explore different areas of art for example; painting, printmaking, jewelry, clay, sculpture, and creating fun projects.

Cooking

Max. 6 2 days a week Tuesday & Thursday 2nd, 3rd & 4th Grades \$225
 Come learn how to cook. The first day students will pick a recipe, prepare a list of ingredients, and then shop for them. On the second day students will prepare, cook the meal, and enjoy what has been made. Followed by cleaning up, of course! (To cover the cost of ingredients and materials an additional fee has been added to the cost of this program.)

Fall Explorers

Max. 14 2 days a week Monday & Wednesday Lower students \$210
Max. 14 2 days a week Monday & Wednesday Middle students \$210
 Students will have an opportunity to experience adventure based outdoor activities; hiking, group initiatives, and team building challenging activities. Students should come prepared with proper clothing for inclement weather, ready to work as a team and ready to challenge themselves.

Lower Fun/Homework

Max. 6 2 days a week Monday & Wednesday Lower students \$210
 2 days a week Tuesday & Thursday Lower students \$210
 Students will either play outdoors, play board games, or have drawing/coloring for half of the time. The second half, students will have the opportunity to start their homework. Students may not complete their work so we encourage parents to check their child's work
